## SPACE

...we've needed it for a long time. Our Ryan Hall home is great for meetings and the kitchen works especially well when food is part of the main menu. But because we share our space with so many other organizations, storage is at a premium. We have our materials stored in five different closets and cupboards in the Church basement. This is hardly conducive to good organization and inevitably leads to items being lost and the expense of replacing them.
